Meeting Summary:

Kim Hastings: Questions why the report did not contain important information about the modules such as; special modular for heavy snow-loads and the availability of them.

Peter Kasprzyk: This was not in the report because John Ciardi had just arrived back that day.

Paul Morrill: We need to wait to see how the school board views our proposal. Beating this deal amongst us is not important at this time. We need to wait and give

school board some time. Let's give them some room to work on it tonight. Hopefully, there will be some back up on their decision. The taxpayers have allocated for this money we need to justify.

The code officer is going to see if these units meet the code requirements.

Kim Hastings: We need to be conscientious about our emails. So we need to consider making phone calls for those people who don't check their emails regularly.

Peter Kasprzyk: Would like to invest in some software that would project the value of the facility to see if it is a viable thing or it is a waste of money. It is called the 50 year life cycle. Maybe as a building committee look into this.
